

Apex Dance Club Constitution

Article I: Name

The organization shall be known as the Apex Dance Club. This will also serve as the name of the club for the time being (Name subject to change).

Article II: Purpose

The purpose of this school organization is to promote school spirit, enthusiasm, and exercise.

Article III: Membership

Membership consists of any Apex students who would like to join the club.

Article IV: Election/Appointment of Officers

Officers will be appointed by the president on a merit based system and then later through elections.

Appointed Officers will serve in the position indefinitely and will be appointed by the club president. Appointed Officers can be removed in one of two ways.

1. by vote by the squad (impeachment)
2. removed from office by the President

Should an office be vacated for any reason, a vote will be held to replace that office. In this vote, all team members are eligible to vote, after the beginning of the fall term. Officers shall not be on academic or disciplinary probation at the time of their elections and throughout their terms in the office. Officers will be appointed based on ability to teach and behavior.

Article V: Duties and Positions

Positions may be delegated to several people if they are too much for one person to handle.

Section 1: Leaders

President

The President will hold the position of tiebreaker, arrange meetings, and be the spokesperson for the club.

Vice President

The Vice President will fill in for the President if he is incapacitated or unable to go to the meetings.

Section 2: Officers

Music Managers

The Music Manager will select a wide variety of songs to listen to. Club members will then vote for their favorites. These songs will be played more than others. Other members can bring in music if they want to.

Style Trailblazers

It is not possible for one person to teach everyone everything they want to know. The best person in each style of dance or specific technique will be in charge of teaching that technique to new members and existing members.

Publicity Managers

The Publicity Manager will be in charge of promoting the club. He or she will make flyers, posters, and recruiting new members.

Club Advisors

The Club Advisor will think of ways to financially support Dance Club and help determine what is needed most. This position does not exclusively deal with financial situations. They will solve problems as they come up. If we do not have speakers, the Club Advisor would coordinate with people to bring in speakers from home or borrow them from the media center.
