

# Constitution of the Apex High School German Club (Deutschklub)

## Article One (Purpose)

*Deutschklub* provides culturally enriching activities that develop and promote a broader understanding of the German-speaking peoples and their language and promotes the study of German at Apex High School.

## Article Two (Membership)

Membership is open to all students of Apex High School, but especially to those who are enrolled in German classes. Within Wake County guidelines, a membership fee of one dollar per semester is required.

## Article Three (Officers)

1. Officers are chosen from dues-paying members of *Deutschklub* and must have at least one year of prior membership.
2. Officers must maintain at least a 2.667 G.P.A.
3. Officers are elected by vote of dues-paying members of *Deutschklub*.
4. Officers are to be selected by May or in September for the upcoming school year.
5. Officers shall consist of a President, a Vice-President and a Secretary.
6. If not enrolled in German for the full year, the President and Vice-President may not have the same semester of German un-enrollment. At least one of these two officers must be enrolled in German in any given semester.

## Article Four (Activities)

Major activities shall be held at least once per semester. Activities will include guest speakers, German cooking, or a visit to a restaurant. Meetings will occur regularly (weekly or bi-weekly) on a designated day after school. Meetings and activities will take place outside of normal instructional hours.
