

# **Pink Ribbon Club Constitution**

## **Article I: Name of Club and Sponsor**

The club's name shall be: Pink Ribbon Club and its faculty sponsor is: Ms. Maret Jones

## **Article II: Purpose of Club**

The mission of the club is to increase teen awareness of breast cancer, provide community service opportunities, and raise funds. The club will create opportunities for students to gain community service through a fun and meaningful way. The club will also be educated about breast cancer and learn ways to help the fight. Anyone who is interested can join the club and does not require any prior skills.

## **Article III: Powers**

The constitution may be changed by future club officers or by a majority vote. The constitution may also be changed if the Pink Ribbon Club Foundation has any national changes.

## **Article IV: Meetings**

Meeting will be held in Mrs. Jones room- Pod O every other Tuesday from 2:30 to 3:00.

## **Article V: Membership**

Members may miss up to five meetings and after that must have an excusable reason. Members have the option of buying a club shirt; prices will depend on the amount of members who want to buy a shirt. A member will be dropped if they do not attend enough meetings and fail to show up to an event they signed up for. Officers will be replaced if they fail to complete tasks given to them. Mandatory club requirements is strictly just attendance and going to a majority of the events.

## **Article VII: Officers and Duties**

The president will be responsible for communicating with the Pink Ribbon National Club Foundation, overseeing all events, working with all officers, pass the Pink Possibilities binder down to the incoming President. The vice-president will be responsible for helping out all members, preside over meetings when the president is not present, help the president and other officers when in need. The secretary will be in charge of keeping attendance of members present at meetings, recording all information into minutes for people absent, and keep track of emails and papers. The treasurer will be in charge of budgeting events and communicating with the president and the national foundation on financial needs and fundraisers. The public relations officer will be in charge of the shirts, promotion of club and events, taking pictures at events, and making it seen to the public

## **Article VIII: Elections**

Officers may only be juniors and seniors with a GPA of a 3.0. Elections for officers will occur at the first meeting every year. The term of the position will end only if the officer graduates or is no longer a member. An officer must be nominated by two members and then voted on by majority.

## **Article IX: Activities, Projects and Community Service**

Participation in a minimum of two out of club events per year such as Susan Komen Race for the Cure are required. A minimum of two fundraising events per year such as sport events, bake sales, selling items are required. Volunteer opportunities will also be in the Pink Possibilities binder provided by the national club.
